

**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTHFIELD  
OF INTENT TO ISSUE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS  
FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Township of Northfield, County of Washtenaw, State of Michigan (the "Township"), is considering creating a public indebtedness through the issuance of capital improvement bonds pursuant to Act 34, Public Acts of Michigan, 2001, as amended, in the amount of not to exceed Four Million Six Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$4,665,000), at a meeting of the Township Board of Trustees on October 13, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. Eastern Time, to be held remotely accessible by <https://zoom.us/j/94590130251> for the purpose of paying the cost to acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping improvements to the township's sewage disposal system, consisting generally of a wastewater treatment plant equalization tank, including all related appurtenances and attachments thereto. Members of the public are invited to attend.

The bonds will be payable in annual installments not to exceed twenty (20) in number. The bonds and the interest thereon will be from the general funds of the Township lawfully available for such purposes including property taxes levied within applicable constitutional and statutory tax rate limitations. The township anticipates paying debt service on the bonds from revenues of the township's sewage disposal system.

This notice is given pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance 08-05 of the Township Code of Ordinances (Division 5, Sec. 2-272, et seq.).
